ABOUT THE ORGANISATION

The European Democratic Party (EDP) was founded by François Bayrou and Francesco Rutelli in 2004, and was promoted by Romano Prodi. As a centrist European political party, it brings together political parties and MEPs who all want a Union closer to the citizens who live in it. The EDP is a transnational political movement campaigning for a European democracy based on the shared values of peace, freedom, solidarity and education, while aiming to proudly affirm its culture in tomorrow's world. The EDP currently has 11 MEPs from 5 countries and 18 Member organisations from 14 countries.

ABOUT THE CALL FOR TENDER

The European Democratic Party wants to launch a **weekly podcast on European affairs** to be published on <u>Radio Leopolda</u> and possibly on other online channels.

The Party is therefore looking for a someone that we could repeatedly use every week to **research and record a 30min press review of news in France, Germany, Italy, Spain and news at EU level**. The candidate would therefore need to be a journalist or have a journalism background. S/he would need to be able to review the news in these countries and then summarise/analyse them during a 30min audio recording.

In terms of the content produced, the EDP staff has a right to review the recording before publication and the EDP is then free to use the recording as necessary.

The recording would need to be done **every week in Italian and English**: the same content recorded once in Italian and then recorded again in English. The candidate would therefore need to be able to understand the press in German, Spanish, Italian, French and English.

The technical equipment necessary to produce the recording can, if necessary, be provided by the EDP.

TENDER EVALUATION CRITERIA

The criteria we will use in order to determine the best value for money are the contractor's:

- **1.** Ability to meet the requirements set out above.
- 2. Knowledge of current affairs in these countries and Europe-wide.
- 3. Availability, technical capacity and previous experience.
- **4.** Ability to understand and communicate in different languages, especially English, French, Italian, German and Spanish. Knowledge of other European languages will also be appreciated.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications should be submitted in **English and Italian** to Léo Wilkinson by email at <u>L.wilkinson@democrats.eu</u> with "Application – Podcast presenter Radio Leopolda" in the subject line. Please send a 1-page motivation letter, CV and examples of previous work. The contractor should also provide a quote with an estimate for how much s/he would charge to produce each podcast.

The deadline for applications is the 6^{th} of February 2022. Review of the offers will take place during w/c 7 February.
